TIP:

Types of grants:

- **Research grant**—awarded for the purpose of conducting basic or applied research.
- **Training and career development grant**—awarded for the purpose of enhancing the education and experience of promising scientists. May be awarded to an academic institution to help establish, expand, or improve professional programs.
- **Personnel preparation**—awarded for the purpose of increasing the number of personnel within a discipline (e.g., SLPs, pediatric audiologists, PhD-level faculty)
