

# The Value of the Speech-Language Pathologist (SLP) in Schools: Prevention and Response to Intervention



Preventative support involving school-based SLPs improves students' communication and literacy skills.

## When compared with usual instruction, small-group support involving the SLP leads to improvements for...

## **Preschoolers**



- 71% of preschoolers improve phonemic awareness.1
- Preschoolers identify initial sounds 4 times more often.<sup>1</sup>
- Preschoolers show 3 times more improvement in story retelling, with skills maintained at 4-week follow-up.<sup>2</sup>

#### Following just two hours of additional support...

42% fewer students with mild articulation errors require special education services.<sup>3</sup>

#### Students who receive narrative instruction...

- Demonstrate 5 times more improvement in written narrative skills.<sup>4</sup>
- Demonstrate 11 times more improvement in oral narrative skills.<sup>4</sup>
- Demonstrate 2 times more improvement in narrative language production.<sup>4</sup>
- Maintain gains in narrative skills at 5-month follow-up.<sup>4</sup>

#### Multilingual students who exhibit difficulties in language and literacy skills demonstrate improved outcomes, with...

- · 2 times more improvement in narrative production, 5 times more improvement in oral narratives, and 3 times more improvement in written narratives.5
- 80% of students improving their morphosyntactic skills to within normal limits following bilingual SLP support.<sup>6</sup>
- 73% of students improving their oral language per teacher report following bilingual SLP support.<sup>6</sup>

# **Adolescents**



#### Students who receive intensive SLP inference intervention demonstrate...

- 3 times more improvement in reading comprehension.
- 7 times more improvement in knowledge of course content.<sup>7</sup>

#### Students who receive individual and small-group morphological awareness instruction demonstrate...

- 9 times more improvement in reading accuracy.<sup>8</sup>
- 7 times more improvement in spelling accuracy.8

#### Students who receive small-group phonological awareness instruction demonstrate...

- 12 times more improvement in word identification and reading comprehension.9
- 6 times more improvement in total reading scores on standardized assessment.
- 2 times more improvement in word comprehension.9

# When compared with usual instruction, interprofessional education and collaboration involving teachers and SLPs improve outcomes for...



#### **Preschoolers**



### **Elementary school students**

- Students use 4 times more abstract language during shared reading tasks.<sup>10</sup>
- Students make 2 times more progress on print awareness and phonological awareness tasks.11

#### Within one school year.....

• Students are 6-7 times more likely to achieve age-level decoding and reading comprehension skills, with 94% mastering these skills.12

#### Students show...

- 2-4 times more improvement in receptive vocabulary. 13, 14
- 2 times more improvement in expressive vocabulary<sup>13</sup> and phonological skills.<sup>15</sup>
- 3 times more improvement in non-word reading.<sup>15</sup>

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
